Jesus Is Baptized

BASED ON LUKE 3:15-17, 21-22

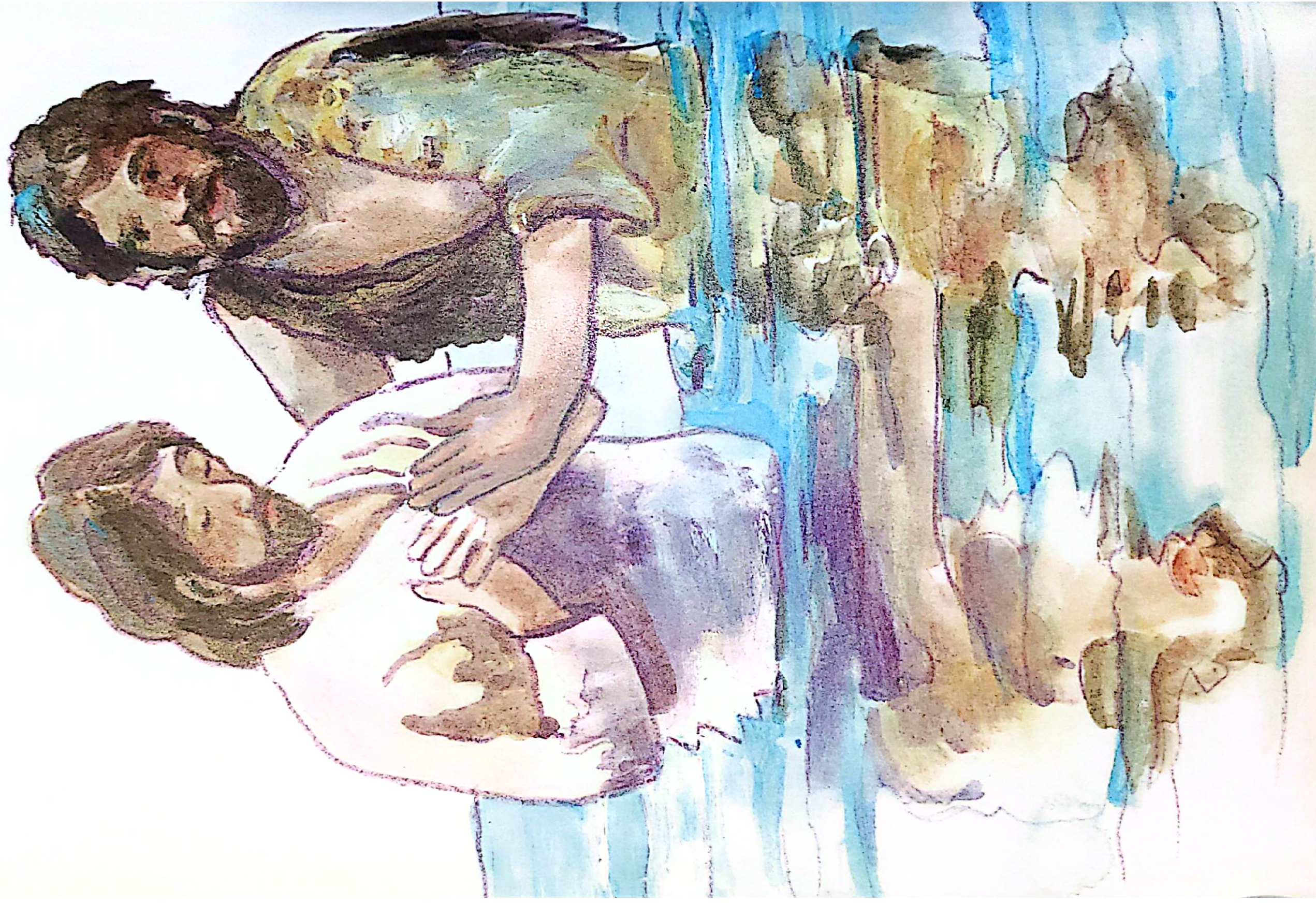

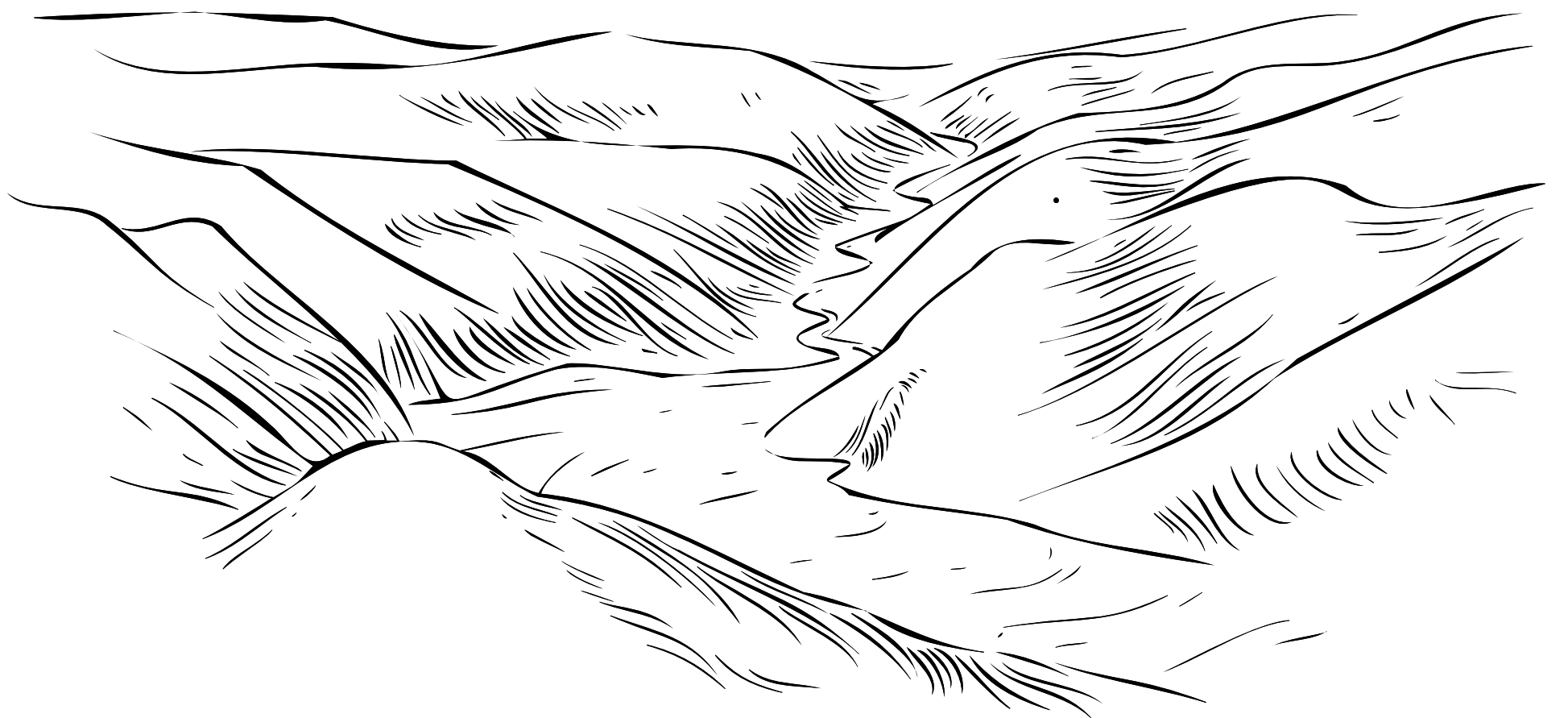
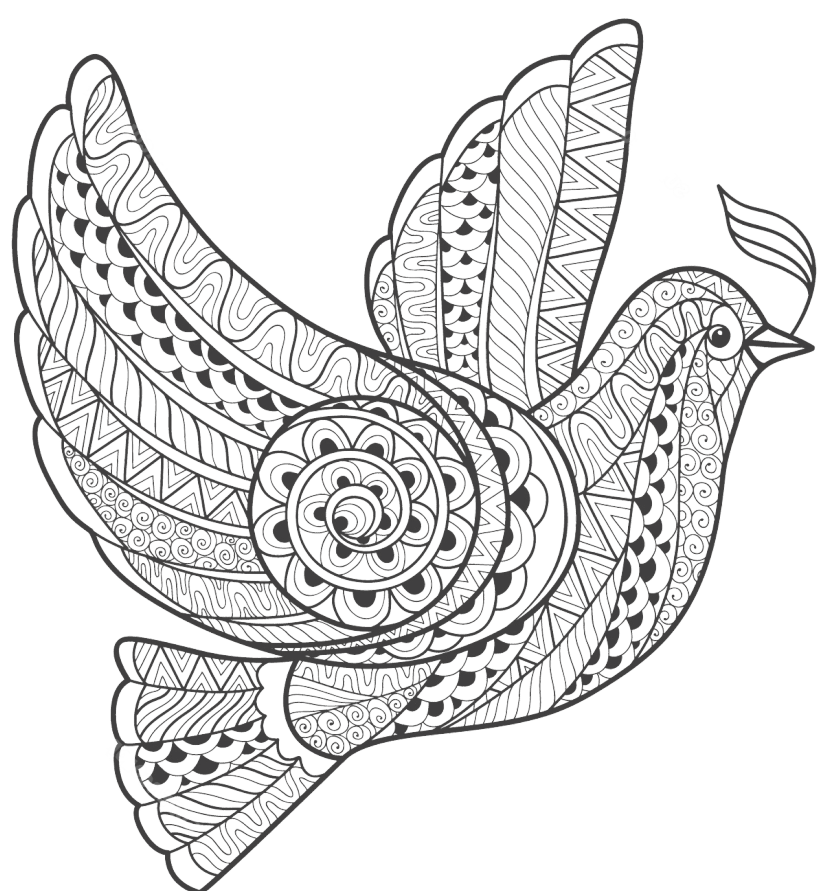

Dove of Peace Labyrinth

Labyrinths (lab-ee-rin-th-s) are special acts of prayer that we make with our body to speak to God, you can walk a Labyrinth or trace one with your finger. When you have found the way through this maze, make it a Labyrinth by tracing your finger along the lines through the maze and along the line from the beginning and ending, together they make a complete circle.

Even if there are twists and turns on the way, they are one, there is no end, like God.

When we do a Labyrinth we can think and pray about things and moving our fingers along these lines help us keep our mind on God and on our prayer.
