


Most of the crowd spread their coats on the road ahead of Jesus. and others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road.








The soldiers made a crown of long, sharp thorns and put it on his head, and they put a royal purple robe on him.




They gambled for his clothes, throwing dice to decide who would get them. Mark 15:24b






